Winnipeg's Indigenous People



Winnipeg is home to over 84,305 residents identifying as Indigenous Peoples, and are 12.2% of the total Winnipeg population. The median age of Indigenous Peoples is 27, compared to 39 of the general Winnipeg population.

32% of Winnipeg Indigenous Peoples did not graduate from primary school, compared to 19% of total Winnipeggers who do not graduate.

The median income for Indigenous Peoples in Winnipeg is **\$25,060**, compared to \$31,505 for all Winnipeggers.

Winnipeg Seniors

99,825 Winnipeggers are over the age of 65. This senior population accounts for 14.15% of Winnipeg's total population.

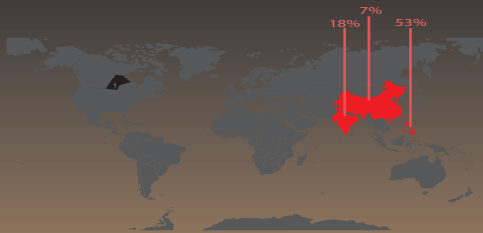

Recent Immigrants



52,020 residents of Winnipeg are recent immigrants, coming from outside Canada within the previous five years. This is 7.16% of the total Winnipeg population.



Winnipeg receives the majority of its immigrants from the Philippines, India, and China.



Despite **58%** of Winnipeg new immigrants having a certificate from a recognized post-secondary institution,

The median income of immigrants is **\$21,011** compared to Winnipeg's median income of \$35,121. Further, **32.6%** live below the Low-Income Measure (after taxes).

Female Single Parents



Over 35,000 Winnipeggers are female single parents. Of this community, 15% are over the age of 65 and 15% are youth, or between the ages of 16 and 29.



62% of single female parents are in the labour force.



51% of single female parents have a certificate from a post-secondary institution. 21% have not completed primary school.



On average, women in Manitoba earn **\$0.89** to every \$1 earned by a male on an hourly basis.



The median income of single female parents is **\$33,071** (after taxes).

24.28% of female single parents identify as Indigenous.
