CAHOOTS (Crisis Assistance Helping Out on the Streets) in Eugene and Springfield answered **17%** of the Springfield Police Services call volume.

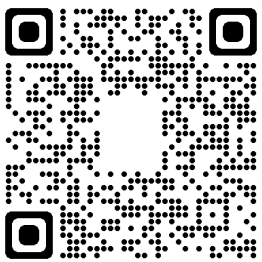
IN 2019, CAHOOTS OPERATING BUDGET \$2.2M. EUGENE/SPRINGFIELD POLICE BUDGET \$90M.

A CANADIAN SUCCESS STORY

Toronto Community Crisis Service (TCCS) pilot launched on March 31, 2022, as a partnership between the City of Toronto and four community organizations.

TCCS pilot completed 6351 calls for service and only asked for police in 240 instances.

At least 107 non-police led crisis teams already exist in Canada and the US.
